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### Materials

3 x 50g balls DK yarn  
Pair 4mm needles

### Back

Cast on 64 sts

Work garter stitch (knit every row) for 10 rows

Change to stocking stitch (K 1 row, purl 1 row) for 40 rows

### Armholes

At beginning of the next 2 rows cast off 4 stitches

At beginning of next 2 rows cast off 3 stitches

Dec 1 stitch at each end of needle on next Right Side row

48 stitches remain\*  
Stocking stitch 50 rows

### Shape shoulders

by casting off 6 stitches at beginning of next 4 rows

Cast off remaining 24 stitches for back of neck.



### Front

Repeat as for back up to \*

Stocking stitch 30 rows

### Neck shaping

With RS (right side) facing work across 19 stitches, join new yarn and cast off 10 stitches for front neck and work to end. There will be 19 stitches on each side.

Working each side separately at each neck edge cast off 3 stitches once, cast off 2 stitches once leaving 12 stitches on each side.

Work until armhole measures the same as the back to the shoulder.

Shape shoulders as for back.

Cast off.



## Child's Jumper for ages 1-2

### **Sleeves (2 alike)**

Cast on 30 stitches

Garner stitch 10 rows

Change to stocking stitch and increase every 4 rows at both sides 14 times (58 stitches)

Work 20 more rows

#### **Shape armhole**

At beginning of next 2 rows cast off 4 stitches.

At beginning of following 2 rows cast off 3 stitches

Decrease 1 stitch at each end of needle on next 3 right side rows.

Cast off 2 stitch at beginning of next 4 rows.

Cast off 3 stitches at beginning of next 6 rows

Cast off remaining 12 stitches.

### **Finishing**

Press pieces lightly to measurement

Sew one shoulder seam.

### **Neckband**

With right side facing, beginning at other shoulder, pick up and knit 1 stitch for every cast off stitch along the back of the neck, pick up and knit 3 stitches for every four rows to centre front neck.

Pick up and knit one stitch for every cast off along the front of the neck, pick up and knit about 3 stitches for every four up to shoulder. Garner stitch 10 rows.

Cast off loosely.

### **Seams**

Sew the remaining shoulder seam.

Sew sleeves into armholes

Sew sleeve and side seams.

Weave in loose ends.

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
