1 pair 4 mm (UK8 – USA6) knitting needles, 4 buttons for Shoes with Ankle Strap.

The quantities of yarn are based upon average requirement and are therefore approximate.

**VERY IMPORTANT- IT IS ESSENTIAL TO WORK TO THE STATED TENSION TO ENSURE SUCCESS.**

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles. If there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles.

**NOTES:** Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets.

Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no sts, rows or times are worked for this size.

After casting off one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow.

Owing to photography and printing restrictions the colour reproduction is matched as closely as possible to the yarn.

### Special Abbreviations

**m1** make 1 stitch – pick up horizontal strand between last stitch and next stitch to be worked and knit into back of it.

## SHOES WITH ANKLE STRAP

### TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over stocking stitch on 4 mm needles, or the size required to give correct tension.

### Sole

Using 4 mm needles, thumb method and M, cast on 7[9:11] sts.

### 1st row.

This row is called **g-st** (garter stitch).

Cont in g-st as follows:-

Work 1 row.

### Toe Shaping

Work 3 rows inc 1 st at each end of next and foll alt row.

11[13:15] sts.

Work 9[11:11] rows more without shaping.

### Sole Shaping

Work 11[19:19] rows dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll 10th [6th:6th] row. 7[5:7] sts.

### For 1st and 3rd sizes only

Work 8 [4] rows dec 1 st at each end of foll 8th [4th] row. 5[5] sts.

### For all sizes

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 5 sts.

### Upper Shoe Part

Using 4 mm needles, thumb method and M, cast on 6[8:10] sts.

**1st row.** Inc in 1st st, knit to last 2 sts, inc in next st, k1. 8[10:12] sts.

### 2nd row.

1st and 2nd rows (without the incs) are called **st-st** (stocking stitch).

Cont in st-st as follows:-

### Toe Shaping

Work 6[8:8] rows inc 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row.

14[18:20] sts.

### Upper Shaping

**Next row.** (Inc in 1st st) 1[0:0] times, k4[7:8], turn and leave rem 9[11:12] sts on a stitch holder. 6[7:8] sts.

Work on these 6[7:8] sts as follows:-

**Next row.** P2tog, purl to end. 5[6:7] sts.

**Next row.** Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 4[5:6] sts.

Work 10[12:12:12:14] rows more without shaping.

### Heel Shaping

**Next row.** P2tog, purl to end. 3[4:5] sts.

**Next row.** Knit to last 2 sts, k2tog. 2[3:4] sts.

Cast off rem 2[3:4] sts purlways.

With rs facing, rejoin yarn to rem 9[11:12] sts, cast off 4 sts, knit to last 2[0:0] sts, (inc in next st, k1) 1[0:0] times. 6[7:8] sts.

**Next row.** Purl to last 2 sts, p2tog.

5[6:7] sts.

**Next row.** K2tog, knit to end. 4[5:6] sts.

Work 12[12:14] rows more without shaping.

### Heel Shaping

**Next row.** Purl to last 2 sts, p2tog. 3[4:5] sts.

**Next row.** K2tog, knit to end. 2[3:4] sts.

Cast off rem 2[3:4] sts purlways.

### Upper Edging

Using 3¼ mm needles and M, with rs facing, beg at inside of heel edge, pick up and knit 13[15:15] sts along straight edge, 7 sts around shaped edge and 13[15:15] sts evenly along other straight edge. 33[37:37] sts.

Cast off.

### Strap for Left Shoe

Join heel seam.

With rs facing, using 3¼ mm needles and M, beg and ending 4[4.5:4.5] cm, 1½[1¾:1¾] in each side of heel seam, pick up and knit 16[18:20] sts from cast off edge, then cast on 16[18:20] sts for strap. 32[36:40] sts.

**Next row.** Knit.

**Next row.** Knit to last 3 sts, cast off 1 st, k1.

**Next row.** K2, cast on 1 st, knit to end. Cast off.

### Strap for Right Shoe

Using 3¼ mm needles and M, cast on 16[18:20] sts for strap then with rs facing, beg and ending 4[4.5:4.5] cm 1½[1¾:1¾] in each side of heel seam, pick up and knit 16[18:20] sts from cast off edge. 32[36:40] sts.

**Next row.** Knit.

**Next row.** K2, cast off 1 st, knit to end.

**Next row.** Knit to last 2 sts, cast on 1 st, k2. Cast off.

### Flower

Using 3¼ mm needles, thumb method, and C, cast on 50 sts, tying a marker thread every 10 sts.

Cast off leaving a length of yarn for sewing.

Sew first st to all marked sts forming 5 petal loops.

Fasten off.

### TO MAKE UP

With seam at centre of heel on the sole, sew upper part of shoe evenly all around the sole. Sew on buttons. Sew a button to the centre of the flower and attach 1 flower to each shoe if required. See ball band for further washing and care instructions.

## SHOES WITH BOW

### TENSION

22 sts and 30 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over stocking stitch on 4 mm needles, or the size required to give correct tension.

### Sole

Work as given for Sole of Shoes with Ankle Strap.

### Upper Shoe Part

Work as given for Upper Shoe Part of Shoes with Ankle Strap.

### Upper Edging

Work as given for Upper Edging of Shoes with Ankle Strap.

### Bows (make 2)

Using 3¼ mm needles, thumb method and C, cast on 12 sts and work 12 rows in g-st.

Wrap a length of yarn approximately 10 times tightly around the centre of the piece, to pull the bow in at the middle. Secure the yarn at the back, then use for sewing to each shoe.

### TO MAKE UP

With seam at centre of heel on the sole, sew upper part of shoe evenly all around the sole. Sew on bows. See ball band for further washing and care instructions.



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
