

## Granny Block Blanket

This blanket really is a classic that anyone can tackle. All you need is a bunch of your favourite coloured yarns - as many or as few as you like - and you're away. Using a simple repeat this is the perfect beginner project to practise your technique and tension.



DK yarn of your choice - approx 250g



5mm/H



The finished blanket measures 70cm by 76cm



16st and 9 rows =10cm by 10cm







## hanjan crochet

#### GRANNY BLOCK BLANKET



About 250g of any double knit wool of your choice



5mm/H



The finished blanket measures 70cm by 76cm



16st and 9 rows = 10cm by 10cm



ch = chain

chsp = chain space

dc = double crochet

htr = half treble

tr = treble

rep = repeat

RS = right side

sk = skip

sp = space

ss = slip stitch

WS = wrong side

#### PATTERN:

Foundation chain: ch80 (or any multiple of 2)

Row 1: htr in 2nd ch from hook, \*ch1, skip 1, htr, rep

Row 2: RS: ch3 (counts as st), \*3tr in each ch1-sp across, tr in last st

Row 3: ch1 (does not count) htr in same, \*ch1, htr between groups of 3tr, rep from \* across to last set of 3tr, ch1, htr in last st.

Rows 2 and 3 create the pattern.

Rows 4-67: Repeat the pattern.

To finish either sew in the ends or tie them to create tassels.
